
LOCATIONS VIEWS

The Editing view will be a hidden row that will open when the button is clicked. This is faster than having to wait for a whole new page to load making maintenance of the list easier.



The delete button will open a dialog for confirmation. Two part system helps to keep from accidentally deleting things. The delete confirmation button is also moved further from where the mouse is than the close link to further protect the user from accidental deletes.


ORDERS

Adding defaults to the dates fields. Check against the current date for defaults as it's likely most order searching will be fairly recent.



Adding a new order will open up the first set of fields. If the order doesn't need delivery, the delivery options remain hidden. This also reduces accidents between pickup and delivery options as you can't enter delivery options unless it's enabled.




As the order is changed to delivery, the rest of the form appears. As they click on dates, they'll see the available slots, to aid in better conversations with their clients. There also needs to be a noticeable difference between available and non available days.

NOTE FOR JEREMIAH: What is the Add a Truck link? I'm supposing this is if the client's delivery exceeds the capacity of just one vehicle? If so, it will simply repeat the truck and driver form below the original. Also, what's supposed to go in the products field?



I don't think the invoice, customer name or order date need to be changed. If they do, this can definitely be adjusted. There isn't specifics on order details, so we'll need that information.

The order details also seems to be the main point of this view, as once a delivery schedule is decided on, it's not as likely to be edited as much as the details need to be referenced. It needs to stand out in a bold way, draw the eye so the dispatcher doesn't need to search.



There wasn't much that needed to be changed here, it seems like this is the page that would need to have a print option? The biggest thing is I added the slots here since there was a lot of excess space and it didn't make sense to have an entirely different page to update the slot information. Will the invoice numbers go to WooCommerce?
